

Some changes are afoot on the list/website, so please read. Sorry for all the words this time!

- Probably the biggest request was to separate out further the years experience, especially on the junior side. So, that's what we did. It's now 0-2, 3-4, 5-7, 8-9 and 10+. We'll try this for a while to see how it works (please shoot me an email if you feel strongly about it either way). Please be aware that creating the new categories has thrown the years experience function on the website into disarray and will take some time before all jobs fall into the new categories (besides 10+). All old 0-4 fall into 0-2 right now and likewise for 5-9 into 5-7. New jobs as of this week will go into the new categories.
- WASH positions are also now divided by years experience in the email
- I've hyperlinked the categories in the email to the same categories on the website, as much as I can, so people can just go to those in their experience category if you choose. This was to appease those who don't like the big lists, but 80% of you did!
- I played with the regions a bit (as you can search by region in the "Advanced search" function on the website if you did not know) to see about adding more, but, in the end, this became convoluted as there are too many sub-regions and there are different ways to categorize different countries, so I switched back to the five. This caused for a loss of previous uploaded jobs to have a regional categorization, so will also take some time to recover.
- We do realize the location search on the website is not ideal and this will be one of the larger fixes that will take some time to carry out. Right now, the website saves geographic locations, so you can start typing in the country, city, or sometimes state/province and if there was or is a job there, it will pop up. Washington DC is a tough one (as was noted by a few in the survey), but if you type "District of Columbia", they are found there.
- I have to do some thinking about further changes that were suggested and, again, some will take some time. Everyone who works on the site does so in their free time, so things just take time. But, we're doing our best to improve your experience.

On to the jobs...
